DECISION OF THE TAUPO DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

The Application

This is an application by **Ruahine Ports Limited** for an Off-Site Special Licence pursuant to Section 138 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 for the **Taupo Sika Show 2019**. It was formally received by the Taupō District Licensing Committee on 20th June 2019.

Reasons for the Decision

The applicant is an experienced operator of special licences and a certificated manager will oversee the sale and sampling of alcohol.

The reports of the Police and the Medical Officer of Health do not oppose this application.

The Decision

I am satisfied that the criteria of Section 142 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 have been satisfactorily addressed by the applicant and the licence may issue subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold on, or delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises, or supplied as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours:

Saturday 28 September 2019 and Sunday 29 September 2019; from 9.00am to 4.00pm on both days.

2. While alcohol is being supplied as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are being supplied.
3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed at the stand.
4. The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons,

- b. If so directed a copy of the licence is to be attached to stall so as to be easily read by people attending the licensed area.

The licensed premises known as "Ruahine Ports" situated at the Tongariro North Domain, Tongariro Street, Taupo (marquee #1, stand number 98), is more precisely identified as outlined in the event site plan provided with the application, as received by the Taupo District Licensing Committee on 20 June 2019.

Taupo District Licensing Committee Special Licence –Off Site

Section 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Ruahine Ports Limited** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at 30 Tongariro Street, Taupo, and known as The Great Lake Centre for consumption off the premises, to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events): **Taupo Sika Show 2019**.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a managers or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Conditions:

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold on, or delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises, or supplied as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours: **Saturday 28 September 2019 and Sunday 29 September 2019; from 9.00am to 4.00pm on both days.**
2. While alcohol is being supplied as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are being supplied.
