**DECISION OF THE TAUPO DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE**

**The Application**

This is an application by **Begin Distilling Limited** for an On-Site/Off-Site Special Licence pursuant to Section 138 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 for the **Juno Jin @ The Taupo Home and Garden Show 2021**. It was formally received by the Taupō District Licensing Committee on 3rd March 2021.

**Reasons for the Decision**

The applicant appears to be a responsible entity to be granted a Special licence and a certificated manager will oversee the tastings, and off sales, at the event.

The reports of the Police and the Medical Officer of Health do not oppose this application.

**The Decision**


I am satisfied that the criteria of Section 142 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 have been satisfactorily addressed by the applicant and the licence may issue subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold on, or delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises, or supplied as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours:  
  
**Friday 16 April 2021 from 10.00am to 5.00pm; Saturday 17 April from 10.00am to 5.00pm; & Sunday 18 April from 10.00am to 4.00pm.**
2. Tasting samples of 5ml in 20ml size tasting cups will be provided, and patrons can only taste a maximum of three samples each
3. While alcohol is being supplied as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are being supplied.
4. A certificated manager OR person nominated by the licensee to be responsible for managing the sale and supply of alcohol must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the stand (number 252).
5. The Licensee must display:

- a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons,
- b. If so directed a copy of the licence is to be attached to stall so as to be easily read by people attending the licensed area.

The licensed premises situated at Stand 252 at The Great Lake Centre, 30 Tongariro Street, Taupo, is more precisely identified as outlined in the "Taupo Home & Garden Show 2021 Site Plan" provided with the application, as received by the Taupo District Licensing Committee on 3 March 2021.

## **Taupo District Licensing Committee Special Licence –Off Site**

*Section 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012*

**Pursuant** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Begin Distilling Limited** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at 30 Tongariro Street, Taupo, and known as The Great Lake Centre - Stand number 252 for consumption off the premises, to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events): **The Taupo Home and Garden Show 2021.**

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a managers or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

### **Conditions:**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold on, or delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises, or supplied as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours:

**Friday 16 April 2021 from 10.00am to 5.00pm; Saturday 17 April from 10.00am to 5.00pm; & Sunday 18 April from 10.00am to 4.00pm.**

2. Tasting samples of 5ml in 20ml size tasting cups will be provided, and patrons can only taste a maximum of three samples each.
3. While alcohol is being supplied as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are being supplied.
4. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the stand (number 252).
5. The Licensee must display:
  - c. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons,
  - d. If so directed a copy of the licence is to be attached to stall so as to be easily read by people attending the licensed area.

### **Duration**

This licence is only in force as specified in Condition 1.
